III. The Covenant

1 Corinthians 11:25 -In the same manner He also took the cup after supper, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in My blood. This do, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of Me."

Greek word for 'covenant' is Diatheke (dee-ah-they-kay) which means:

1. a disposition, arrangement, of any sort, which one wishes to be valid, the last disposition which one makes of his earthly possessions after his death, a testament or will
2. a compact, a covenant, a testament
3. God's covenant with Noah, etc

What Communion Is

- The covenant of the Lord Jesus Christ where we are supernaturally drinking and eating healing to our bodies
- An ordinance established by Jesus to practice as a form of remembrance of Him and what He did for us
- An opportunity to purposefully examine ourselves so that judgment will not be brought upon us

What Communion is NOT

- It is not a time to snack
- It is not a form of ritual or habit and should be taken very seriously
- It is not a one-time event in your life
